Footnotes

MISS WELL MOLDED stalked the early pace just off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead a quarter mile out and held on gamely under some urging. MANGITA sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn and through the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. TANQUERRAY angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside into the stretch, came out in late stretch and finished with interest. WARREN'S ROSEBUD broke inward some, went three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail to the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BLAZEN ALL STAR broke out a bit and steadied, settled a bit off the rail then chased outside a rival to the stretch and lacked the necessary response toward the inside in the drive. AKISS FORAROSE pulled three deep early then chased a bit off the rail, moved up toward the inside leaving the backstretch, swung out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. LIL SWISS ECHO chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. SAGEBRUSH QUEEN pulled her way along inside to chase the pace, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
