SOLDIER'S DANCER unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, went up three deep nearing the second turn, advanced outside, swung five wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to wear down the runner-up. PRESIOUS PASSION close up stalking the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage past midstretch and held on well but was worn down late. UNUSUAL SUSPECT a bit slow to begin, settled between rivals then inside, split horses into the stretch, bid between foes past midstretch and continued willingly. VICTORY PETE three deep early, prompted the pace outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, fought back past midstretch and weakened late. SEMINOLE NATIVE unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail early, found the inside on the backstretch, cut the corner into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and improved position. MR. CHAIRMAN angled in and chased outside a rival, went three deep into and out of the second turn and lacked the needed late kick. ICY ATLANTIC allowed to settle off the pace outside, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. JACK'S WILD settled off the pace inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. LIBERIAN FREIGHTER sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, fought back into the stretch and to midstretch, then weakened. EPIC POWER chased inside then outside a rival, continued between foes on the second turn and lacked a response in the stretch. SWIFT WINDS settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and stalked the pace outside a rival, dropped back between horses then outside on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
