Footnotes

SMALL TOWN GIRL between horses early, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to prove best. SOUVENIR PARTY settled outside and wide into the turn, moved up four wide on the bend and five wide into the stretch and was second best. ERIN sent between horses early, dueled inside but a bit off the rail on the backstretch and between horses on the turn, continued outside a rival in the stretch but could not match the top pair. DEE DEE'S DINER unhurried wide on the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, slipped through along the rail into the stretch, came out and improved position. WINSOME WITCH lagged back a bit off rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and also improved position. PLUS THREE close up inside stalking the pace, bid along the rail on the turn, dueled inside a rival but weakened in the final furlong. RAN FOR THE DOUGH had speed between horses then stalked between foes, steadied off heels into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SCORE SIX a bit slow to begin, was climbing when well off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and was not a threat. SHES MISCHIEF dueled between horses on the backstretch, stalked between foes on the turn and weakened. WEST COAST GEE GEE prompted the pace six wide early

and four wide on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn, dropped back approaching the stretch and had little left. DOIN' IT EASY between horses early, stalked outside on the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and weakened. JAZZ YA raced wide throughout and seven wide into the stretch and gave way. NORTH OF RIO dueled between horses on the backstretch, was shuffled a bit into the turn, dropped back and also gave way readily.
