### Footnotes

RIDE AND SHINE chased inside on the backstretch, split rivals on the turn, moved up inside into the stretch, came out past midstretch and rallied between horses while bumping TIMELY ACTION late and got up nearing the wire. PICO CENTRAL (BRZ) had good early speed four wide then angled in and dueled outside a rival, fought back through a hard drive and continued gamely but was caught late. ARSEN unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, moved up three deep into and on the turn and four wide into the stretch, was bumped late but continued willingly to the wire. TIMELY ACTION had speed between horses then stalked outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, came out three deep into the stretch, was bumped between foes late and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. ROJO TORO dueled between horses then angled in, fought back on the turn and through the drive but weakened a bit late. VOLTERROMO (ARG) chased outside a rival then just off the rail on the turn, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CRACKUP had speed five wide then stalked outside or off the rail, went three deep on the turn, split horses leaving the bend and did not rally. MURANO allowed to settle off the rail on the backstretch, angled in some on the turn, came out a bit leaving the bend and was not a threat. IRISHEYESAREFLYING dueled inside then stalked along the rail, dropped back on the turn and gave way. Following a stewards' inquiry, RIDE AND SHINE was disqualified and placed fourth for interference in deep stretch.
