R DOUBLEDAY sent inside to duel for the lead then fell back a bit a half mile out, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch, gained the advantage nearing the sixteenth pole, kicked clear under urging and held. EULA B. stalked three deep then four wide into and on the turn and into the stretch and continued willingly late for the place. COURAGEOUSANDBOLD stalked a bit off the rail, split rivals on the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch, came out in midstretch and gained the show. ROCK U UP had good early speed and dueled between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled in and fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. SUGAR SPICE dueled three deep then outside a rival into and on the turn, fought back between horses in the stretch, also weakened late, did not return to be unsaddled when bleeding from the nostrils and was vanned off. LAKE OSCEOLA stalked between horses, steadied off heels behind the winner midway on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BEAUTIFUL STRIKE in tight between horses and squeezed early, chased a bit off the rail, came out off heels on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. R DOUBLEDAY and COURAGEOUSANDBOLD wore calks.
