Footnotes

PROSPECTOR'S TRICK angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, rallied under urging along the rail in the stretch to gain the lead in deep stretch and held gamely. DEEP PLAY chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and finished well between foes late. CHRISTOPHER STREET chased between horses then outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied willingly. KESSABTSI stalked off the rail then bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead leaving that turn, fought back between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. WOODMANS LUCK saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail on the second turn ad in the stretch and finished with interest but was outkicked late. TURN ON THE PUMPS sent inside to the early lead, set the pace along the rail, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch, came a bit off the fence in the drive, was in a bit tight between horses nearing the wire. VOLKONSKY chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BENCH LIGHT chased three deep, came out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. GAB POWER hesitated to be away behind the field, angled in a bit off the rail then came out into the backstretch, went four wide into and out of the second turn and did not rally.
