Footnotes

WARP settled outside, moved up off the rail leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied to the front nearing midstretch and pulled clear under some urging. COLOR ME SPECIAL angled in and settled outside a rival, split horses on the second turn, also came four wide into the stretch and finished well for second. LADY CARA saved ground chasing the leaders, came out leaving the second turn, waited off heels in upper stretch, split horses in midstretch and gained the show. UP AT THE TOP (IRE) unhurried a bit off the rail for six furlongs, came out into the stretch and improved position. SISSI SONG (FR) angled in on the first tur4n and chased a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch, then weakened. MISS ALYETTA pulled early, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, came

out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. EARLY ARRIVAL pulled her way to the front, set a pressured pace inside, fought back into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. RAIN DANCER (NZ) saved ground off the early pace, came out leaving the backstretch, launched a bid four wide on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. DAZZLING DIAMONDS pulled her way along off the rail early, bid between horses on the backstretch, dropped back and angled in on the second turn and weakened. DONNA'S TOUR also pulled early, raced close up outside, bid three deep on the second turn and outside a rival into the stretch, continued between foes nearing midstretch and also weakened. LADY SARKA (IRE) four wide into the first turn, bid three deep on the backstretch then between foes early on the second turn, dropped back leaving that bend and had little left. SUORA NOTTE (FR) allowed to settle a bit off the rail, fell back on the second turn and gave way.
