Footnotes

BUCKLAND MANOR four wide into the first turn, dueled outside a rival, kicked clear on the second turn, angled in and proved best under left handed urging. POOR MAN'S BATTLE between horses early, stalked the pace off the rail, moved up inside early on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival late for second. ARBITRATE four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then off the rail, came outside a rival into the stretch and was edged for the place. GONE BALLISTIC angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and improved position in the stretch. TARKOVSKY bobbled a bit at the start, went four wide into the first turn, settled outside, came wide into the stretch and also improved position but was not a threat. ROMEO TANGO angled in on the first turn, saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and did not rally. RANSOM THE KROONER sent between horses early, chased off the rail and weakened. MAJESTIC COMMANDER sped to the early lead, dueled inside the winner, dropped back on the second turn and also weakened. RICHARD'S BOY off a bit slowly, pulled his way along early, chased off the rail, dropped back and drifted out on the second turn and gave way.
