MISS RADIANCE three deep early, stalked between foes then outside a rival, bid between horses leaving the second turn and in the stretch, gained a slim advantage under some urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. BWANA BABE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace toward the inside, inched away again a half mile out, responded when challenged leaving the turn and through a long drive and continued willingly to the wire. HEIDI MARIA four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then bid three deep on the backstretch, moved up again four wide midway on the second turn, re-bid three wide leaving that turn and through the stretch and clearly bested the others. SUMMER SONG close up stalking the pace inside to the stretch, lacked the needed late kick. SCREAMING REGAL settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DERBY MEMO also settled just off the rail chasing the pace to the stretch and lacked a further response. AMBITNESS pulled early, stalked outside a rival or between foes, bid between horses on the backstretch, dropped back into and on the second turn and gave way.
