JOHN SCOTT angled in and sped to the lead outside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail, re-bid alongside that one into and on the second turn, regained the advantage into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, fought back when headed outside the runner-up in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. HUNTSVILLE settled off the pace inside, waited briefly leaving the second turn, got through along the rail, came out in midstretch, split horses past midstretch, bid inside, put a head in front in deep stretch and was outgamed. JULES JOURNEY saved ground stalking the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and continued willingly to best the others. BIG BANE THEORY pulled his way along to chase the pace between horses, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. STONEY FLEECE also pulled and stalked three deep then between foes on the backstretch and second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET fanned out into the first turn, chased four wide, came five wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed rally. SWIFT EAGLE pulled his way up to gain the lead on the first turn, inched away and set the pace inside, dueled along the fence into and on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CIRCLE THE MOON hopped a bit at the start, drifted out into the first turn, chased between foes or a bit off the rail, continued between rivals on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
