LAKERVILLE chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. SWEET SWAP stumbled at the start, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and rallied late for the place. DI GIORGIO (ARG) pulled and stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the hill, split horses in midstretch and again in deep stretch to gain the show. ANKENY HILL had good early speed off the rail, dueled a bit off the fence then inside, fought back when briefly headed in the stretch and was edged late for third. READY FOR MORE stalked outside or off the rail, bid three deep on the hill and into the stretch, briefly put a head in front in midstretch and was outfinished for a minor share between foes. DRILL unhurried off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch and bested the rest. BOAT TRIP settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EL COMMODORE dueled outside a rival then between horses on the hill and weakened in the stretch. HANDSOME MIKE saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
