Footnotes

MISS PIXIE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail and drew off under a moderate hand ride. IRON GLOW between horses early, angled to the inside on the backstretch, advanced inside on the turn and was second best. BLUSH AT TWILIGHT settled outside a rival on the backstretch, split foes leaving the turn, angled out and was along for the show. ALARCITY stalked the pace along the inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch but weakened in the drive. INSIDE STORY was unhurried along the inside to the stretch and improved position but was not a threat. EMPTY PURSE stalked the pace three deep or off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. GRAM'S ROYAL LUCK pulled her way between foes to stalk the winner's pace, continued outside a rival into and on the turn and four wide into the stretch and had little left. RACING RITA steadied in a slow, awkward start, went up outside on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, then gave way readily.
