MELROSE WOODS chased inside, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up four wide nearing the wire. FLASHY DAME between horses early, angled in and stalked inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, put a head in front in deep stretch and was caught late. SALT TEQUILA LIME had speed outside then dueled alongside a rival, inched away and angled in entering the turn, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled back between horses through the final furlong and held third. NIHILIST had speed between horses then dueled inside a foe, stalked alongside a rival into and on the turn, came out into the stretch, re-bid three deep in midstretch and was outfinished between foes late. CHESTNUT MOON broke slowly, came off the rail on the backstretch then angled in some on the turn, continued a bit off the fence into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DIXIE IN PINK broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. BONNIE PARKER settled outside a rival then off the rail, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. LADY VIVIEN between horses early, chased outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail on the turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened.
