MATTO MONDO (CHI) pulled his way along inside then chased a bit off the rail, moved up outside leaving the second turn and six wide into the stretch, surged to the front under some urging while drifting in a furlong out and drew clear. HUDSON LANDING stalked three deep then off the rail, continued four wide leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and edged rivals for the place. JAIRZIHNO (GB) a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals past midstretch and got up for third between foes late. DEACON SPEAKIN' saved ground chasing the pace, also came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and just missed third. SKY CAPE stalked between horses then outside a rival, continued between foes on the second turn, came out into the stretch, and was outfinished for a minor award. WHERE'S THE REMOTE settled outside a rival chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. BIG WAGS saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. MUNY stalked three deep then bid outside a rival on the backstretch, tracked that one three wide on the second turn and four wide

into the stretch and weakened. GOLDEN MEXICO (IRE) had speed between horses then angled in, set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn and into the stretch, continued a bit off the rail in the drive and weakened in the final furlong. KESSABTSI chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
