Footnotes

CHOCHECHERYMARY settled inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the second turn, split horses into the stretch, came out past midstretch and rallied under urging to get up late. CALIFORNIA NECTAR sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the second turn and in the stretch, fought back along the rail in the drive and continued willingly but was edged late. SECRET COVE came off the rail early, chased outside a rival, angled out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just got the show four across the course on the line. HALO DOLLY stalked the pace off the rail under a hold, bid alongside the runner-up on the second turn and through the stretch but could not get by and was edged for a minor award late. BENCH GLORY angled in outside a rival then found the rail on the first turn, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside into the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. ANTARES WORLD stalked the pace off the inside, fell back some on the second turn, came into the stretch three wide and weakened. WARREN'S GOT GAME a bit slow to begin, settled inside then just off the rail, went outside on the second turn and a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat.
