Non-Winners of two races other than claiming or starter since November 28 allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming or starter since then, 4 lbs. (Horses eligible only to the above allowance conditions are preferred.) (Starters for a claiming race of \$25,000 or less in their last three starts and maidens that are non-starters for a claiming price have second preference). Rail at 15 feet. (NW2 X)

Footnotes

DESERT HERO angled in and chased the leaders inside down the hill, came out into the stretch, rallied to the front past midstretch, drifted out a bit when briefly clear in deep stretch and gamely held under urging. KING SLAYER (GB) dropped back from between foes down the hill, came three deep into the stretch, waited in traffic in midstretch, then split rivals and closed willingly between foes while bumped nearing the wire. CONCURRENT dropped back without early speed after an alert beginning, settled outside, came wide into the stretch, came out off heels in midstretch and closed with a rush on the far outside while bumped late. COURT COSTS pulled between foes early, stalked outside down the hill, swung wide into the stretch and had a mild bid. SHEIKH ABANDON saved ground off the pace down the hill, came out crossing the dirt and lacked the needed late response. GYPSIESINTHEPALACE sped to the early lead, dueled outside a rival to midstretch and weakened. DOLFIKAR (IRE) settled outside, came five wide into the stretch, was a bit crowded in deep stretch and lacked the necessary rally. LIGHT FINGERED (IRE) was four across the course early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail down the hill and weakened. ONE MAN ARMY pulled his way along and was in tight at the right hand curve, continued outside down the hill and six wide

into the stretch and did not rally. ONE HUNDRED SLEWS saved ground throughout and failed to menace. KING OF SWING bobbed and was crowded at the start, angled in down the hill and did not rally. BIRDLAND JAZZ (AUS) pulled his way along inside to the lead, dueled inside a rival to midstretch and weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the bumping between the second and third place finishers at the wire but made no change when they ruled the incident occurred too close to the wire to alter the outcome.
