GARDEN IN THE RAIN (FR) stalked the pace a bit off the rail or outside a rival, angled inward in upper stretch and rallied along the rail under some urging to win clear. ARABIC SONG (IRE) saved ground chasing the leaders, came out into the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch, could not match the winner while clearly second best. MISS PUZZLE (AUS) pulled her way to the front between horses, set the pace inside, battled between foes in midstretch and weakened but held third. ADALGISA pulled early when three deep, prompted the pace outside a rival, also battled between horses in midstretch and weakened. TAMARA PRINCESS (BRZ) off a bit slowly, stalked three deep, drifted to the inside in the stretch and had little left. BALDWINA (FR) also a bit slow to begin, pulled just off the inside chasing the pace and lacked a response in the lane.
