Footnotes

O NECTAR had speed outside then stalked off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch, took the lead nearing midstretch, kicked clear under urging and held. SATAN'S SONG tracked the leader off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and continued willingly but could not catch the winner. OURWHISTLEBRITCHES chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and just held third. DOTTED SWISS dropped back off the inside on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the turn, came out in the stretch and just missed the show. SAILOR'S DREAM sent between horses to the early lead, inched away leaving the backstretch, kicked clear a bit off the rail on the turn but weakened in the final furlong. MISSLE DO saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and was not a threat. LITTLE BIT WESTERN bobbled and had the ground break out behind to be off slowly, moved up outside on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn and wide into the stretch, then lacked a further response. SAH WOOSH chased between horses then just off the rail, angled to the inside for the turn and gave way in the stretch.
