Footnotes

SEVEN BELOW dueled a bit off the rail then inched away leaving the backstretch, set the pace off the inside, drifted out a bit in the stretch but won clear under urging. STRAY CAT stalked outside then three deep on the turn and into the stretch, drifted in some and just held second. MOTORBOAT settled inside then a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and finished fast to just miss the place. MINNIE'S BOY had speed between foes then stalked between horses, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CUBS MOLINA broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, waited off heels then slipped through inside past midstretch and improved position. SUR BRIO between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. INCANDESCENZA broke a bit slowly, settled three deep then off the rail, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat.

MARIA'S CAT also a bit slow to begin, settled outside or off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. BANDEIRA BAND chased between horses then angled in for the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. HAGGIS MACPHERSON close up stalking the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, weakened in the stretch. GOLDEN DELIGHT stalked three deep, split rivals on the backstretch, continued three wide on the turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive. MORT ROBBINS had speed between horses then outside the winner, stalked off the rail then between foes on the turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened.
