ACE OF ACES (IRE) sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in and set the pace inside, responded when challenged in the stretch, fought back along the fence under urging in the final furlong and held on gamely. STERLING OUTLOOK stalked the winner outside a rival then off the rail leaving the hill, bid outside that rival in the stretch and continued willingly but could not get by. ATTICUS JACK chased inside then outside a rival leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and bested the others. DOMONATION pulled a bit early then settled outside, went three deep leaving the hill and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DETROIT DONNIE close up stalking the pace inside, came out crossing the dirt and into the stretch and weakened. PACK YOUR BAGS between horses early, steadied in a bit tight off heels at the right hand curve, angled in and saved ground on the hill, came out a bit into the stretch, drifted in late and lacked a further response. NICE MOVE broke through the gate and unseated the rider prior to the start, threw his head at the break and was off a bit slowly, went up between horses then chased outside a rival, angled in entering the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
