**Footnotes**

RUSSIAN BAYOU unhurried off the rail early, angled in some on the backstretch, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch, rallied under some left handed urging while drifting in to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and won clear. COPARCENARY stalked between horses then just off the rail leaving the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch, bid along the rail in midstretch, took a short advantage past the eighth pole, was not a match for the winner late and just held second. SIEMPRE ESPERANZA chased outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. CAPALATTE settled three deep then chased outside a rival, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. CLEVER CHLOE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear leaving the backstretch, came off the rail in the stretch, battled outside a rival in midstretch, then weakened. BROOKLYN ROSE dueled three deep then stalked outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. COSSET went up between horses to duel for the lead, stalked off the rail into and on the turn and weakened in the stretch. MYSTERY BIRD broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail chasing the pace, fell back into the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. BENECIA had good early speed and stalked the pace inside, dropped back leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
