Footnotes

THE DEPUTY (IRE) sped between horses early, angled in and dueled inside HIGH YIELD to deep stretch, then inched away late under a crack of the whip and steady handling. HIGH YIELD three deep early, vied for command outside the winner until the final stages, could not match that one but was clearly second best. CAPTAIN STEVE stalked the dueling leaders along the inside then a bit off the rail under urging on the second turn, drifted out some in the stretch and weakened but bested the rest. GREY MEMO settled off the rail, split horses on the second turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. HASTY KRIS was unhurried well off the rail on the first turn, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground thereafter but did not rally. WOOSTERSHEAR came a bit off the rail early and pulled his way between foes into the first turn, stalked outside CAPTAIN STEVE to the second turn, then drifted out and gave way readily.
