**Footnotes**

HIGH TIDE RISING bumped at the start, chased between horses, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and closed gamely under urging to get up nearing the wire. UNCLE DON bumped between foes at the start, stalked inside, continued along the rail in the lane, waited a bit off heels passing the eighth pole, got through past midstretch and went willingly late. OL'DOGTOWN also bumped at the start, was sent between horses then chased a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and rallied gamely between foes. DON'T ANSWER stalked between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, gained the advantage outside the pacesetter in midstretch, inched away briefly, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened late. MAGIC DUST had speed off the rail then stalked outside, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. CHAILEPIS between foes early, stalked outside a rival then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SHARK CITY broke out and bumped a rival, sped to the early lead, dueled a bit off the rail then inched away inside on the turn, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. IMAGE AND LIKENESS had good early speed then stalked between horses or off the rail, split rivals three deep on the turn and weakened in the stretch. THE LAST BOY unhurried outside then off the rail, angled in alongside a rival on the turn and did not rally. STAKE A CLAIM (NZ) settled outside then three deep, continued off the rail into the turn, angled in leaving the turn and was not a threat.
