MAGIC MAMA broke slowly, moved up inside on the backstretch, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, rallied under some urging to gain the lead outside the runner-up in deep stretch and proved best. JACOBITA had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear into the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch but could not match that one late. WARREN'S JAZZ WALK stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and clearly bested the others. CHA DA BOOM dueled outside the runner-up, dropped back into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and weakened. WOODMAN'S LASS allowed to settle outside then off the rail, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. ENERGIA SOLAR a bit slow to begin, angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued along the rail under some urging into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and was not a threat. IF YOU DO I SUE broke a bit slowly, chased between horses, was bumped and in a bit tight into the turn and weakened. TUSUN stalked between horses then three deep between foes leaving the backstretch, was bumped and steadied between foes into the turn, continued outside a rival on the bend and had little left for the stretch.
