Footnotes

EXPLAIN chased off the rail, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging while drifting in some to be along in time. SEEKING THE SHERIF sped to the early lead inside, set a pressured pace along the rail, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the fence into the stretch and held on well to deep stretch but could not contain the winner late. MASTER CHEF stalked three deep then outside a rival, was between horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and edged a foe for third. HADFUNLASTNIGHT stalked between horses then bid outside the runner-up to press the pace on the backstretch, tracked that one off the rail on the turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong but just lost the show. GNARLY DUDE pulled his way up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and also weakened. CANDY WALTZ dropped back between foes just after the start, saved ground chasing the pace and lacked a response in the stretch.
