Footnotes

NOCHES DE ROSA (CHI) pulled her way along to stalk the pace outside a rival, bid outside the leader into the stretch, took a short lead in upper stretch, inched away under some urging and held under strong handling. SNOWFLAKE (IRE) stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. KEYS TO THE HEART pulled early, stalked inside, came out into the stretch and finished with interest but just missed the place. POLAIRE (IRE) stalked outside a rival early, angled in tracked the leader a bit off the rail and lacked the needed late kick. SO WISTFULLEE took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner into the stretch, and weakened some in the final furlong. MISS GAZON (IRE) pulled a bit early, stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out in the stretch, was a bit crowded past midstretch and lacked the needed response. VIERNES (BRZ) pulled between horses then angled in and saved ground off the pace, swung three deep into the stretch, was being pulled up in the final sixteenth when lame and was vanned off.
