Footnotes

CANDACE IN ASPEN saved ground chasing the pace, awaited room inside leaving the second turn, got through along the fence into the stretch, bid inside to gain the lead past the eighth pole under urging then pulled clear. COINER came a bit off the rail on the first turn, stalked outside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch to loom a threat outside in midstretch, could not match the winner but bested the others. GIN RUNNING veered out at the start, settled outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, waited behind foes in midstretch, came out and narrowly edged a rival for third. EXTRA FANCY stumbled at the start but recovered and went between horses early, angled in and saved ground close up stalking the leader, came out into the stretch, split rivals with a bid in midstretch but was outfinished. VERY RACY close up stalking the pace outside a rival or a bit off the rail, angled out into the stretch, put a head in front between foes in midstretch, then weakened. CRAFTIQUE took the early lead and angled in, set a moderate pace under a long hold along the inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened once challenged.
