Footnotes

GO FOR PUDDIN stalked four wide down the hill and into the stretch, bid outside the leader in midstretch and gamely prevailed after a hard drive. NENA MAKA (GB) sped between horses to the early lead, kicked clear down the hill, fought back inside in the stretch and just failed to hold off the winner. AL DESIMA (GB) crowded early, settled toward the inside, came out into the stretch and finished well. GUTHRUN (FR) off slowly and steadied at the start, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, was a bit crowded in upper stretch but put in a late bid after splitting rivals. SHE'S GRAND bobbled at the start, raced unhurried down the hill, came five wide into the stretch and also found her best stride late. LADY CADET had good early speed and angled right, stalked three deep down the hill and off the rail into the stretch, angled in some and weakened. TERA KITTY steadied when crowded early, pulled her way along outside a rival, came out for the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SAND PARTRIDGE (IRE) angled in unhurried down the hill, came out for the stretch and did not rally. TORGAU (IRE) off a bit slowly, moved up inside down the hill, came out nearing the dirt and into the stretch but lacked the needed response. WAFER settled off the rail down the hill and was outrun. SHEBA SPRING (IRE) went up between rivals early,

pressed the pace along the inside then stalked on the rail down the hill and weakened in the stretch. FLOWINGTON (IRE) forced the early pace between horses then stalked between foes to the stretch and also weakened.
