Footnotes

CAME HOME stalked the pace along the inside, came out leaving the turn, bid three deep into the stretch, took command under left handed urging past the eighth pole and pulled clear. JACK'S SILVER unhurried well off the rail early, angled in a bit off the fence on the backstretch, came out in upper stretch and finished well to gain the place late. WERBLIN had good early speed and dueled inside rivals but a bit off the rail, found the fence on the turn, fought back inside in the stretch, could not match the winner and lost second late. POPULAR dueled between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, battled between foes in upper and midstretch but weakened. LINE RIDER saved ground chasing the leaders, came out in the stretch and did not rally. MIGHTY DAVID forced the pace three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, dropped back outside the winner on the bend and gave way.
