Footnotes

SPLITUDEUR (FR) off a bit slowly, angled in early, pulled along the inside, came off the rail on the backstretch then angled back in, lacked room briefly into the stretch, was blocked and steadied along the inside in midstretch, bulled through past midstretch and gamely prevailed. ABSOLUTE CHARMER (IRE) pulled early, angled in and stalked a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid outside the leader and bumped with that one in midstretch, then continued gamely but was outfinished. JAVA (GB) also pulled early, chased outside, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch, drifted in through the drive but finished with interest. VIEW FROM THE TOP took the lead in the stretch the first time, set the pace along the rail, inched away again leaving the second turn, came a bit off the rail and was bumped between foes when the winner bid past the eighth pole and was outfinished but shared fourth place. TREKKING stalked the pace between horses, was shuffled back in traffic leaving the second turn, awaited room in upper stretch, rallied between horses in the drive then steadied off heels in deep stretch. BELLA VOLARE unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and improved position. CLASSIC CHATTER stalked outside a rival or between horses, bid three deep on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. SUNSET

SERENADE pulled early, saved ground off the pace, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SWEET FRIPPERY was in a good position stalking the pace outside, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. TANGARA (NZ) took the early lead then stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses into and on the second turn but weakened in the stretch.
