BEHINDATTHEBAR stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn, was fanned five wide into the stretch, made the lead while being mildly hand ridden in midstretch, drifted in, kicked clear and proved best under a long hold. TIZ WEST dueled inside, inched away into the turn, drifted four wide into the stretch, cold not match the winner in the final furlong but bested the rest. EL MARTILLO chased outside then three deep, came out five wide into the stretch and gained the slow. HIGHEST HUMOR chased inside, moved up leaving the turn, bid along the rail in the stretch and was outfinished for third. HOME FOR HARLAN broke inward, dueled between horses then stalked between foes on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ST. CHARBEL broke a bit slowly then steadied when crowded, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. STREETS OF HEAVEN dropped back off the rail then angled in and saved ground to no avail. PEACE PROSPECT bobbled slightly at the start, had speed three deep then stalked outside, dropped back between horses on the turn and weakened.
