ET TU WALKER stalked four wide then three deep, came four wide into the stretch, gained a slim lead in late stretch and gamely prevailed. OVER AFRICA had speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, took a short lead on the turn, inched away into the stretch, fought back along the rail in the final furlong and went gamely to the wire. TIME TO DOUBLEDOWN chased inside, was in a bit tight into the turn, came out on the bend and five wide into the stretch and rallied late for the show. HIDDEN QUEST chased off the rail then between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for third. TRAWEEK had good early speed then stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and was outfinished. COYOTE ROAD chased between horses then off the rail, steadied off heels nearing the quarter pole, split rivals in the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. STAR NAVIGATOR settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. AGENTS BRUCE settled between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, was in a bit tight into the stretch, came out in the drive and went between foes late. NATE DAWG chased outside or between foes then off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn, slipped through in the stretch but lacked the needed rally. BLING CHA BLING chased outside then three deep into and on the turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. RIO GOOD settled outside then alongside a rival, came out leaving the turn and six wide into the stretch and was not a threat. HEZA FOX had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and weakened. EATON HALL went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
