FLASHBACK had good early speed and angled in, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch and second turn, inched away again a quarter mile out and drew off in the stretch under a left handed crack of the whip and a vigorous hand ride. DEN'S LEGACY had speed between horses early then tugged his way along to stalk a bit off the rail on the first turn, angled in and tracked the pace inside on the backstretch and second turn, continued along the fence in the stretch and edged a rival for the place. HE'S HAD ENOUGH three deep into the first turn, stalked outside the runner-up then bid alongside the winner on the backstretch and second turn, continued outside the runner-up leaving that turn and in the stretch and was edged for the place. LITTLE JERRY settled inside then came off the rail into the backstretch, chased outside the runner-up then three wide into the stretch and weakened.
