SECOND PROPOSAL moved up between horses on the backstretch, waited behind horses nearing the quarter pole, slipped through on the inside at the top of the stretch, came out some in the final furlong but drew clear. IT IS LIVING WATER stalked the dueling leaders on the backstretch, moved up three deep into the turn, bid three deep on the turn, came into the stretch three wide, drifted inward in midstretch, could not match strides with the winner but was a clear second at the wire. I BUY GOLD was bumped at the start, moved up to duel for the lead on the inside, came off the rail into the stretch, steadied between horses in midstretch but held third at the wire. QATAR'S PEARL chased the pace four deep on the backstretch and into the turn, came into the lane four wide and was edged for third on the wire. TAKE A RISK dueled for the lead on the outside down the backstretch and between horses on the turn, steadied between horses into the stretch and gradually weakened through the final furlong. MAHOGANY RUN was bumped at the start and off slowly, chased on the inside, came out on the turn and did not threaten. SILVER LOVE chased three wide on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, gave way in the lane and was not persevered with in the final furlong.
