Footnotes

ALL THE GEARS broke slowly and was rank when angled inward, steadied when rank stalking the leader on the backstretch, bid outside that one on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched clear and proved best under strong handling. ADMINNIESTRATOR between horses early, angled to the inside in the run to the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch then outside a rival, angled three deep into the stretch, was not a match for the winner but best of the rest. HEYERDAHL settled off the inside, angled in on the second turn, then rode the rail in the stretch to pick up the show. ZAFONIC'S SONG (FR) pulled a bit along the inside early, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FRENCH MINISTER between horses early, chased outside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch and did not rally. TIMBER THUNDER settled outside tracking the leader, went three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. COUNT OFTHE KNIGHT took the early lead and the rail, set the pace under a long hold, dueled inside the winner on the second turn, dropped back between foes nearing midstretch and had nothing left.
