Footnotes

REDATTORE (BRZ) stalked the early pace then bid three deep on the backstretch, dueled the rest of the way, put a head in front past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under some late urging. EUCHRE sent to the early lead, set a pressured pace along the inside, fought back through a long drive and continued willingly to the wire. IRISHEYESAREFLYING stalked off the rail early then bid outside the runner-up, dueled between horses, gained a short lead into the stretch, fought back through the drive, weakened some late but held third. LIDO PALACE (CHI) well placed stalking the leaders between horses then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out some into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. SEINNE (CHI) close up stalking the pace along the inside, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. STRAIGHT FLUSH (BRZ) between horses early, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn, drifted in some late and was not a threat. GANDER allowed to settle a bit wide into the first turn, chased three deep, dropped back into the stretch and weakened.
