HESABULLY had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, took a short lead on the second turn and gamely inched away late under some left handed urging and strong handling. MEGABYTE sped to the early lead, dueled inside the winner, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch, could not quite match that one late but gamely held second. SO LONG BIRDIE broke out and bumped a rival, went four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, moved up some three deep into the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, lugged in a bit through the drive and just missed the place. YES HE'S A PISTOL stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late response. GO COYOTE JOE chased a bit off the rail, angled in for the second turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. ZATS IT bumped at the start, angled in and settled inside, came out for the second turn, was forced out a bit in upper stretch and was not a threat. JOLLY MON pulled his way three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
