Footnotes

FLEET CONTINENTAL had speed three deep then prompted the pace outside a rival, stalked midway on the turn, re-bid alongside that one leaving the turn, took the lead into the stretch, kicked clear, drifted in a bit late but held under urging. RELENTLESS HEAT chased outside, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch, advanced under left handed urging in the drive then had the rider lose the whip nearing the sixteenth pole, drifted in late but finished well to just miss. TWOATTEN TENATTWO broke in and slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, split rivals nearing midstretch, was a bit crowded behind the top pair in deep stretch and bested the others. CLOCKER MOMENT broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, angled in leaving the turn, continued inside in the stretch and went willingly late. KESSABTSI between horses early, was climbing some while chasing the pace off the rail on the backstretch, continued between foes on the turn, was in a bit tight leaving the turn and weakened. MAGICAL INSTINCT settled off the rail then angled in some on the backstretch, waited momentarily then split foes on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HANDRIDE sent inside to duel for the lead, inched away briefly early on the turn, battled inside the winner but off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
