SPECIAL KID bumped between horses at the start, stalked the pace inside, waited a bit leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up three deep on the line. RED SHARP HUMOR broke out and bumped a rival, took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, fought back from the fence in the stretch to regain the advantage in deep stretch and was edged late. FUSA CODE stalked outside a rival, went up three deep into the second turn then bid alongside the runner-up, took a short lead in the stretch, battled outside that one in deep stretch and was between foes on the line. BALLADRY between horses early, chased outside, went up four wide into the second turn, continued outside the winner, angled out into the stretch and bested the others. SOUTHERN SCULPTOR bumped and steadied between foes just after the start, saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. EASY PLEASE bumped between horses at the start, settled just off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. STERLING LEGEND bobbled a step out of the gate, settled off the rail then outside on the backstretch and second turn, came four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. T HALL broke in a bit, stalked outside a rival then bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch, dropped back between horses on the second turn, angled in entering the stretch and weakened.
