MOLENGAO (BRZ) saved ground off the pace, came out in midstretch, lugged in a bit in deep stretch but rallied under urging to edge the runner-up late. BALL FOUR dueled outside a rival then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back into and on the second turn and into the stretch, inched away again in deep stretch but was caught late. EL ROBLAR chased inside then outside a rival, bid alongside the runner-up leaving the backstretch, dueled for the lead until past midstretch, weakened some late but held third. PREACHINATTHEBAR had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked on the backstretch and second turn, came out leaving that turn and into the stretch and weakened. SOUTHERN AFRICA angled in and saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and did not rally. FAIRBANKS stumbled a step out of the gate, chased outside a rival or three deep, continued alongside a foe on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened. BILLY ALLEN (IRE) chased outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
