MODIFICATION chased three deep then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came out three wide into the stretch, rallied under good handling to gain the lead a sixteenth out and won clear. CARMEL COFFEE stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went three deep leaving the second turn, took the lead alongside a foe into the stretch, fought back past midstretch and held second. SPINNING YARNS prompted the pace outside a rival then inched away and angled in on the backstretch, fought back a bit off the rail into the stretch then inside and saved the show. DIVINE LEGACY stalked between horses then inside on the second turn and was outfinished for third. PERSIAN EXPRESS a step slow to begin, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHEZA MANEATER dueled inside then stalked just off the fence, was between horses a quarter mile out and weakened. QUEENOFALLDIAMONDS pulled her way along four wide into the first turn, chased outside then four wide again leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened.
