Footnotes

BAD BOY was outrun down the backstretch and around the turn, swung out for the drive, came in slightly in midstretch, and was up for the score in the late stages. SELF INSURED pressed the pace from the outside down the backstretch, was between horses on the turn and into the lane, battled to the wire and gave way grudgingly. NITRO ACTIVE sped to the early lead, was inside a three horse spread on the turn, continued to battle on the inside through the lane and was outfinished in the late stages. STREETS OF HEAVEN stalked on the outside down the backstretch, was three wide on the turn and into the lane and gradually weakened in the final furlong. MY MAN MURF broke alertly, pulled his way along on the inside down the backstretch, swung out for the drive, steadied between horses inside the furlong marker and was outfinished thereafter. A claim of foul by the rider of MY MAN MURF against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards who ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
