SIBERIAN HEART angled in and chased the pace inside, slipped through along the rail with a bid in the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, kicked clear and held under urging. FIVE SILVER STARS stalked the pace outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and gained the place outside foes late. JANA GAIL chased a bit off the rail then inside, continued along the fence on the second turn and in the stretch and outfinished the pacesetter for the show. TOMMY'S PICK sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch, inched away again a half mile out, got clear on the second turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lost third late. HOT CITIZEN settled off the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and around a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FINALITY PHILLY angled in outside a rival then stalked off the rail, bid between horses midway on the backstretch, continued inside into the second turn, came out some leaving that turn and into the stretch and weakened in the drive. TIZ O' GOLD between horses early, lugged out some on the first turn, angled in and chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and did not rally. NASIRIYAH'S SONG settled outside a rival, dropped back leaving the second turn, gave way and was eased late. MOON STONE MADNESS hopped in a slow start, pulled her way up three deep on the first turn and into the backstretch, bid three wide and briefly put a head in

front midway on the backstretch, stalked outside a rival into and on the second turn, gave way in the stretch and was eased in the final furlong.
