Footnotes

SETSUKO stalked inside, split horses into the second turn, bid three deep then outside the runner-up, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and won clear under a steady hand ride. FIDDLERS AFLEET had good early speed and dueled between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. AMERICAN BLEND four wide into and on the first turn, chased outside, continued four wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch, drifted in some and picked up the show. GRAEME CRACKERJACK settled a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. ERBEIA unhurried inside then off the rail, went around a rival on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also improved position but was not a threat. ADMISSION pulled his way along to duel inside, fought back on the second turn, fell back some nearing the stretch and weakened. WELCOME HOME RYAN chased between horses or a bit off the rail, split rivals leaving the second turn and lacked the needed rally. KILLER BEAR also chased between rivals early then just off the

inside on the backstretch and into the second turn, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. INDUSTRY LEADER stalked the pace three deep then off the inside leaving the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. RED ACE broke inward and a bit slowly, angled to the rail and saved ground chasing the pace but had little left for the stretch. COLUDA had speed four wide then dueled three deep, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
