Footnotes

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER fanned out a bit into the first turn, stalked the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the leader on the second turn, took the advantage into the stretch, kicked clear under urging, drifted in and proved best. EMPIRE WAY settled a bit off the rail, angled to the inside on the second turn, cut the corner into the stretch and gained the place along the fence. GROOVIN' SOLO stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in some in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. ROUSING SERMON in tight between horses three deep into the first turn, stalked three wide to the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. ISN'T HE CLEVER pulled his way to the early lead and lugged out into the first turn, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn, came off the fence into the stretch, drifted out a bit in midstretch and weakened. SKY KINGDOM in a bit tight between horses into the first turn, stalked between foes then off the rail leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. CHIPS ALL IN pulled his way along four wide into the first turn, dropped back outside on the backstretch, fell back again on the second turn and gave way. LIAISON tugged early, stalked just off the rail then between foes on the backstretch, continued a bit off the fence on the second turn, was between horses in upper stretch, clipped heels and lost the rider passing the eighth pole. Following a stewards' inquiry, GROOVIN' SOLO was disqualified and placed last for interference in midstretch.
