Footnotes

CROSSING THE LINE (NZ) broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, came out in upper stretch and rallied under some left handed urging and good handling to gain the lead in late stretch to prove best. AVULSION stalked just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch, rallied between horses to a short lead in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. LORO pulled his way up outside to stalk the pace, continued alongside a rival leaving the hill, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. FORMAT V. between foes early, chased off the rail, angled in on the hill, came out in the stretch and was outfinished. MARK THE BENCH was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. QUIETLY MINE between horses early, angled in on the hill, chased a bit off the rail then inside, split horses into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. DEVOTED MAGIC chased outside then four wide after the right hand curve, angled in outside a

rival leaving the hill, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. CAUGHT A FLYER had speed outside foes then dueled alongside a rival, gained the advantage in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened late. WILD REVENGE dropped back outside after an alert beginning, angled in a bit off the rail on the hill and was not a threat. FORWARD COMMITMENT bobbled in a bit of a slow start, settled inside chasing the pace and lacked a rally. HOWMUCHISIT went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the hill and until past midstretch, then weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
