LOVE ALL THE WAY broke slowly, was outrun well off the rail on the backstretch, angled in some on the turn, came out in the stretch and rallied gamely under urging to gain the lead in midstretch and won going away. LET'S GO SURFING showed good early speed and dueled inside a rival but a bit off the rail, inched away in midstretch, got clear but could not withstand the winner's closing surge. THE TOY MAN settled well outside SEI on the backstretch and turn, split rivals in deep stretch and rallied for third. SEI (ARG) bobbled slightly at the start, had a rail trip, gained ground in the stretch but lacked the needed rally. STRAIGHT MAN dueled outside the runner-up until nearing midstretch, dropped back a bit then had little left in the final furlong.
