ARCHER CITY SLEW saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and wore down his rivals under left handed urging. JOOPY DOOPY stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch, went up three deep into the turn, bid outside GIBSON COUNTY into the stretch and took a short lead in midstretch, then fought back gamely between foes late. GIBSON COUNTY broke in and bumped a rival, sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in leaving the turn, fought back when headed in the stretch and continued gamely along the inside to the wire. MALABAR GOLD pulled early, settled outside, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a response. FORTIFIER broke inward to bump a foe and bobbed slightly, went between horses early, continued off the rail and failed to menace. TAVASCO bumped lightly at the start, saved ground on the backstretch and into the turn, came out leaving the turn and was outrun.
