YES HE'S A PISTOL dueled three deep then outside a rival, inched clear into the stretch and proved best under a steady hand ride. WHEATON HALL bid between horses on the backstretch then stalked a bit off the rail, came out nearing the stretch and was second best. CAPE TOWN KING chased between horses then outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. OCEANUS (BRZ) unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. TAIASLEW went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. MOON MISSION allowed to settle off the rail, angled in some on the turn and did not rally. PURE AMERICAN chased inside, came out into the stretch, angled back in and was not a threat. PACKY hopped and threw his head at the start, pulled his way between horses to stalk the pace, steadied in tight .leaving the turn and weakened. PATRIOT'S PASS steadied off heels early, stalked outside then three deep into the turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
