Footnotes

CHAMPAGNE TOPPER sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, drifted out from the whip in the stretch but drew clear. TITIAN stalked outside, went three deep on the turn, came out into the stretch and just edged a rival late for the place. ANSWER TO ABBY chased off the rail, angled in some leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and was edged late for second. BRERETON PARK stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the turn and in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. WARREN'S A LEGEND settled off the pace inside, came out a bit leaving the turn, found the rail again in the stretch and did not rally. RUN MARK RUN broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out some in the stretch and failed to menace. RINO SONG between horses early, stalked outside a rival, dropped back between foes on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. DISCOVER JR angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
